Your high school student is enrolled in a 2018-2019 Advanced Placement course based on their preparation for such courses, their willingness and ability to meet academic challenges, and the level of support they receive from family and friends. Student registration opens on January 7, 2019, and closes on March 6, 2019. Late registration takes place from March 14th through March 27th – please note additional processing fees will be added to late registrations.

We highly encourage you to purchase the tests early, online through the Student Store with a credit card. **PRINT YOUR RECEIPT TO BE SURE YOU CHOSE THE CORRECT TEST!**

AP tests may also be purchased in the College and Career Center (CCC) with a **check only** made payable to CVUSD.
