- > Enter your SMC ID# & Password Your first password is your six digit date of birth: MMDDYY
- > Click on "Enrollment"
- Select term (i.e. Winter, Spring, Summer, or Fall)
- > Select "Add a Class" and/or "Search for Classes" Refresh by selecting "new class search"
- > Select "Wait for a Class" (Enter section number). 2 class max. & must attend first class meeting

PAY: View your Fees & Pay for your classes for Summer/Fall: Check "Corsair Connect" for payment deadline
After payment deadlines pass, you must have a zero balance by mid-night of the same day you add course(s)

Pay fees on-line on "Corsair Connect" OR pay in person: Bursar's Office (building across from Assessment Center)

HELPFUL HINT: Don't forget to pay and have a zero balance or you will be dropped from all of your classes
