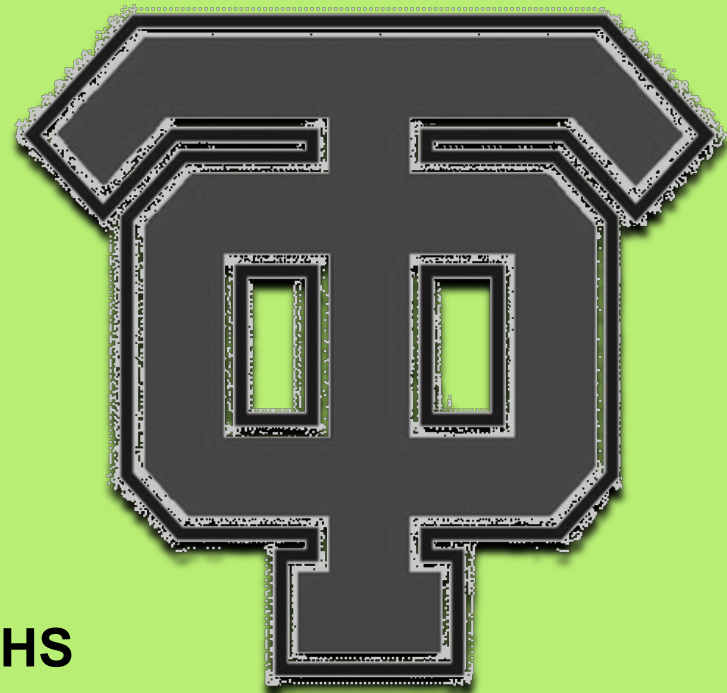

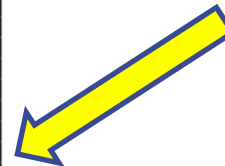

CSU EXPOSITORY READING/WRITING COURSE (ERWC)

- NEW English Course Offering for 12th grade year
 - Designed for the high-achieving CP student who nearly meets the college-level writing requirements for CSU and UC English courses
 - Passing ERWC with a C- or better eliminates the need for a remedial college English class.
- 

4TH YEAR OF HIGH SCHOOL MATH IN 12TH GRADE YEAR

- Taking a math course in the senior year strengthens students skills to be better prepared for college coursework
- The CSU (and UC system) highly recommends students complete a 4th year of math
- No GAP year!
- The completion of a 4th year of math with a C- or better is considered for placement in GE math courses

Must complete a math above
Algebra 2CP

UC & CSU REQUIREMENTS

Complete 15 A-G courses (11 of them by end of junior year)

You need to complete a minimum of 15 college-preparatory courses ([A-G courses](#)) with a letter grade of C or better, with at least 11 courses finished prior to the beginning of your last year of high school.

The 15 courses are:

a. History	2 years
b. English	4 years
c. Mathematics	3 years
d. Laboratory science	2 years
e. Language other than English *or equivalent to the 2nd level of high school instruction	2 years*
f. Visual and performing arts	1 year
g. College-preparatory elective (chosen from the subjects listed above or another course approved by the university)	1 year

A grade of D+ or below in any “A-G” requirement should be remediated

CTE PATHWAY COMPLETER

- **CTE Pathway - two or more courses in the same career sector**
 - First course - concentrator
 - Second course - capstone
- **If you currently in a CTE class, consider taking the second course!**
- **Benefits of CTE Pathway Completion:**
 - Opportunity to earn industry certification - build your resume
 - VCCCD 2+2 articulation to bridge to college classes
 - Deeper knowledge and develop skills in career sector
 - Work-based learning opportunities - mentorships, internships
 - CVUSD CTE Completer Certificate
 - Graduation cord in your pathway
