# Filling out Applications

- Have your transcript information near you (**on Q**)
- Middle school coursework can be added
  - It might say “courses before high school” **OR** you can add the middle school course work in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade section
  - **Remember!!** All middle school classes that were for high school credit are already on your high school transcript
- If you have taken any dual enrollment or college classes, **YOU MUST** specify that you have taken a college class
- Do not report it under high school course work; it is only reported under College course work
- **You are a high school graduating Senior WITH college credit!!!**

# Naviance

- Everything that you need to know, you can access through Naviance
- Log in and access the ***Colleges*** tab
- Counselors send items through Naviance
- Naviance is using **single sign on** so use your google learn e-mail and google learn password

# UC and CSU Schools

**UC** – Application open August 1<sup>st</sup>; submission from November 1<sup>st</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup>

**CSU** – Application opens October 1<sup>st</sup>. Submission from October 1<sup>st</sup> – November 30<sup>th</sup>. \*\* individual campuses have different deadlines. Please check with each school you are applying to

- **CSU Apply** - <https://www2.calstate.edu/apply/Pages/default.aspx>
- **UC Apply** - <https://apply.universityofcalifornia.edu/my-application/login>
- No letters or transcripts needed to send for UC/CSU for application; everything is self reported

# Fees/Waivers

- **CSU and UC fee waiver is embedded in the individual applications**
  - The application fee is \$70 for each campus.
  - When you apply for admission through the individual application, you are automatically considered for an application fee waiver based on the information inputted
  - You must fully complete the application before the fee waiver eligibility is determined
  - If you are eligible for a fee waiver, you can waive up to 4 application fees – so that could be 4 for UC schools and 4 for CSU schools

# Common Application

- Request Transcript
- Request letter of rec – counselor/teacher
  - Match Common APP with Naviance in the *Colleges* tab
- Once requested, counselor will handle:
  - School Profile
  - Secondary School Report
  - Sending letter of recommendation



# Letters of Recommendation

- Request letter from teacher via e-mail and send e-mail invite through Naviance
- Ask teachers in a timely manner
- **IF NEEDED:** Make your college counseling appointment with your counselor at least three weeks before FIRST deadline
  - Appointments will be 20 minutes in length
  - Please e-mail Mrs. Costales to set up a counseling appointment – [acostales@conejousd.org](mailto:acostales@conejousd.org)
- MUST complete student brag sheet and parent brag sheet (***About Me – “Surveys”***)

# SAT/ACT Testing

- **CSU** - temporarily suspended the use of ACT/SAT examinations in determining admission eligibility for all CSU campuses for the 2021-2022 academic year. This temporary change of admission eligibility applies only for fall 2021, winter 2022, spring 2022, fall 2022, winter 2023, and spring 2023 admission cycles
- **UC** - ACT & SAT: UC will not consider SAT or ACT test scores when making admissions decisions or awarding scholarships. If you choose to submit test scores as part of your application, they may be used as an alternative method of fulfilling minimum requirements for eligibility or for course placement after you enroll
- **Private schools** - Most schools are test optional
  - You can report scores if you have them
  - Must send scores directly:
